In 2016, we launched our Agrii 'iq' training programme, which we believe is an industry leading initiative to support new talent in Agriculture.

Between 2016 and 2023 60 Trainee Agronomists have started their iq journey on the 'educate' programme with many of them now successful Agronomists.

Our 'educate' programme is an 18 – 24-month programme comprised of 15 – 20 modules. During this period, you will spend time building your BASIS knowledge along with technical knowledge and core interpersonal skills to help you throughout your careers.

This training supports you to gain your professional qualification, with the BASIS Certificate in Crop Protection and FACTS being essential to your role.

Our iq training is broken down into 4 programmes.



During this period, you will also have regular check-ins with your Area Business Manager and Mentor to ensure that you have the right support to flourish and deliver in your role.

Once graduated from the 'educate' programme you can develop further, many of our people go on to study for their BASIS diploma, typically starting with BASIS Soil and Water.

Everyone completing our iq programmes has the opportunity to meet key individuals within the business to learn more about the different areas, and we are continually reviewing and evolving the iq programmes to ensure that they remain fit for the future challenges agronomists will face.

We have run the iq programme for several years; it aims to be a tailored and user-friendly training programme, iq stands for i-qualify.

Trainee Agronomists and Crop Input Specialists are a key focus, but the programme is open to anyone who wants to improve their skills in a specific area that is aligned to their role.

We do not have a fixed number of people who do iq. Instead, we prefer to tailor the training to each intake of new recruits. Along with the programme, we also offer bespoke training for everyone. For some, this could mean more practical training; others will need it to be more academic.

The iq programme differs from other businesses by not being entirely fixed, either with the number of new entrants or the make-up of the programme. The same rule applies when a new entrant develops their career in Agrii.
